



Woodlawn Preserve

The City of Schenectady has formally recognized that the Woodlawn Preserve is a park, with all the protections that designation has to offer. If you look at the City of Schenectady website, you will now see the Woodlawn Preserve listed with all the other parks within the City. Thanks to Ed Kosiur and all the City council members who voted in favor of reaffirming that status.

It's been a beautiful autumn in the Preserve. On October 10th the Hudson Mohawk Bird Club led a walk in the Preserve. It was a beautiful day and quite a few Ruby-crowned Kinglets were seen. No new ATV damage was noted, thankfully, but our man Dave Berard is in there frequently. He has seen some motorbikes and did catch an ATV riding around on the dunes. So, traffic is less, but we are still seeing activity. They City has promised us some jersey barriers that are now in use but should be available shortly. We hope to use them to make egress from the railroad tracks even more difficult.

Our plan for the handicapped accessible trail to the deck overlooking the pond is in the hands of Chris Wallin, the city engineer. He has discussed it with Mayor McCarthy and Steve Strichman, and feels it is a rather straightforward project. We are looking forward to seeing this completed in the near future.

We have been taking advantage of the Albany Pine Bush Commission's (APBC) expertise and meeting with them on a more frequent basis. I've also met with Wendy Craney, Outreach Coordinator for the APBC. They will be printing up more brochures for us and are willing to help us with tabletop displays, etc. They have also offered the use of their educators to lead walks in the Preserve. The Pine Bush Discovery Center offers an ongoing schedule of activities for children and adults. If you want to learn more about the Woodlawn Preserve, visit the Pine Bush Discovery Center!

Watch for a new Meetup group for the Friends of the Woodlawn Preserve to promote upcoming activities within the Preserve. Information about this will be sent via email and also in the next issue of the Woodlawn Connection.

Looking at Ways to Better Insulate your Home this Season?

Handy Hint #1 - "Seal those Doors"

Address those doors that open to the outside. Gaps at the bottom of doors means loss of heat. Address that with a draft barrier to keep the warm air from escaping and the cold air from coming inside. You can find them at most home improvement stores. They come in many shapes, sizes and designs, from practical to decorative.

Handy Hint #1 - "Caulk your Windows"

When your windows were installed, they were sealed to the frame to help keep your house insulated. But over time, this seal breaks down and gaps form, making convenient escape routes for your heat. If these gaps between your window frame and windows exist, time to break out the caulk and seal them up. Don't know your way around a caulking gun? Just go to: https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=-8cXoLV_seA and learn.

Handy Hint #1 - "Wrap your Hot Water Tank"

Proper insulation of your hot water tank can save on your winter energy costs as well. If you have a tank-style water heater, especially an older one, chances are the insulation is worn down. Buy an insulation blanket from your local hardware or home improvement store and give your hot water tank a nice warm hug. This should cut down on the energy needed to keep your hot water, hot. You may want to first heck with your utility to see if they offer water heater insulating blankets at low prices. Some utilities even install these at a low or no cost.

Abandoned homes are a cause for alarm in neighborhoods. Many, including the mayoral candidates, voice their concern on this subject.

Recently, my cause for alarm was raised when I was approached by National Grid regarding a home in my neighborhood. They asked whether I had recently seen the home owner. Their reason for asking is that they had turned off the house electricity and wanted to be let in to shut down the gas supply. I answered that I hadn't seen the neighbor for over a month but someone had recently seen him elsewhere. I asked NG whether the police could let them in. The answer was yes, but it's a lengthy process and involves getting a search warrant.

Concerned about the possibility of vandalism, squatters, broken water pipes, not to mention a gas explosion, I trekked over to city hall. The city's Office of General Services noted my concern and recorded my name and phone number.

By the way, if one suspects that a home is a candidate for abandonment, there is a red flag. The payment of taxes is public record. Many abandoned homes, including the one in my neighborhood, have overdue taxes. City hall has the records.

I was recently asked whether there is a city ordinance regarding roaming cats. While at city hall, I inquired and the Office of General Services told me there is none.

And thank you Woodlawn community for coming out and bringing your dishes to share. We set a great attendance milestone with over 200 people in attendance. We'd also like to thank Frank Hackert for his \$40 donation and Anita Paley for her \$100 towards the park's redevelopment efforts!

Trustco Bank will soon be finalizing their renovations at the park and will cap that off with a volunteer day. We're still coordinating the date and details - they'll either be volunteering on our rake day or during the playground installation day. While there, Trustco will hold a press day to promote their partnership with the city of Schenectady and the good work they have done to give back to the community.

Playground Coming Soon: We're getting closer to our Community Build Day! The city just completed the footprint mapping for the new playground areas which will be just beyond the current swing sets. The old playground pieces which no longer served their purpose were taken out and trees were removed where the new playground areas will be added. They will soon excavate those areas, digging down one foot to add post footings for the new playgrounds and the protective, pressed-wood, mulch carpet to be laid. Once the excavation is complete, we will hold our community build day. We hope to shoot for a November 7th or 14th community build day - this will be contingent on readiness. Please check our facebook page periodically to find out the date. We will also post information on the date at the park's entrance and fliers will go out in the neighborhood. We hope you can join us to give a helping hand.

We'd also like to extend a great big THANK YOU to the Schenectady East Rotary! Their pancake breakfast fundraiser and matching grant yielded a \$3,000 donation towards the toddler section of the new playground. 


