A Message From Neighborhood Association President:

STAR Registration Program – IMPORTANT INFORMATION Deadline December 31

New legislation requires **all** homeowners receiving a Basic STAR exemption to **re- register** with the New York State Tax Department in order to receive the exemption in 2014 and subsequent years. Information regarding this process was mailed to your home earlier this year. You can register by calling **(518) 457-2036** or going to the website –

https://www8.tax.ny.gov/STRP/strpStart You will need to confirm that the property is the primary residence of one of its owners (married couples with multiple residences may only claim one STAR exemption) and confirm that the combined income of the owners and their spouses who reside at the property does not exceed \$500,000. The online process takes not more than five minutes to complete.

Senior citizens receiving Enhanced STAR benefits are not affected by the new registration requirement, which applies to <u>Basic STAR</u> benefits only. Please be sure to apply before <u>December 31</u>.

Woodlawn Preserve

We purchased and placed an additional 18 jersey barriers in the Preserve, blocking some of the more wide open access points, which has effectively reduced the amount of ATV traffic as compared to the previous year. Still some vandalism occurring in the form of illegal fires, evidence of partying, and dirt bikes, so this is an ongoing process. Thanks to Dave Berard for his ongoing commitment in monitoring the activity in the Preserve.

News about the fish stocking project: the DEC sent a letter to the mayor requesting permission, and the mayor signed. Come spring, the DEC will be in there to test the water quality, assess the depth, and assist in stocking. The possibility exists that they may declare it a state water. We are also a few steps further along in the design phase for the handicapped platform which will allow handicapped access to fishing in the pond. Many thanks to Cole Denning for his continued coordination of this effort.

Many thanks to a new volunteer, Arden Lawand. Arden is a retired graphic artist, and with her talents we now have a beautiful design for the Woodlawn School garden. We are waiting for approval from the school administrator to proceed with the project; hopefully some of the infrastructure can be in place before the snow flies. Arden is also assisting with a tri-fold brochure hikers will be able to use when navigating the Preserve.

In recognition of the holiday season our next meeting will be a combined November/December meeting, to be held on December 4th at the Hibernian Hall at 7pm. All are welcome.


